1 (1) In section 2 in the matter preceding division A,
2 strike the matter relating to division H and insert: “Divi-
3 sion H—Further Continuing Appropriations Act, 2026”.

4 (2) On page 4, strike lines 17 through 25.

5 (3) Beginning on page 1132, strike line 9 and all that
6 follows through “Sec. 554.” on page 1235, line 16, and
7 insert:

8 **“DIVISION H—FURTHER CONTINUING**
9 **APPROPRIATIONS ACT, 2026**

10 “SEC. 101. The Continuing Appropriations Act, 2026
11 (division A of Public Law 119–37) is amended by striking

1 the date specified in section 106(3) and inserting ‘Feb-
2 ruary 13, 2026’.

3 “SEC. 102. For the purposes of the Continuing Ap-
4 propriations Act, 2026 (division A of Public Law 119–37),
5 the time covered by such division shall be considered to
6 include the period which began on or about January 31,
7 2026, during which there occurred a lapse in appropria-
8 tions.

9 “SEC. 103. Amounts made available in the Con-
10 tinuing Appropriations Act, 2026 (division A of Public
11 Law 119–37) and the Consolidated Appropriations Act,
12 2026 for personnel pay, allowances, and benefits in each
13 department and agency shall be available for payments
14 pursuant to subsection (c) of section 1341 of title 31,
15 United States Code and such payments shall be made.

16 “SEC. 104. All obligations incurred and in anticipa-
17 tion of the appropriations made and authority granted by
18 the Continuing Appropriations Act, 2026 (division A of
19 Public Law 119–37) and by the Consolidated Appropria-
20 tions Act, 2026 for the purposes of maintaining the essen-
21 tial level of activity to protect life and property and bring-
22 ing about orderly termination of Government function,
23 and for purposes as otherwise authorized by law, are here-
24 by ratified and approved if otherwise in accord with the
25 provisions of such Act.

1 “SEC. 105. ”.

2 (4) On page 1235, strike lines 22 and 23 and insert:

3 “This division may be cited as the ‘Further Con-
4 tinuing Appropriations Act, 2026’.”.
